## Byki play clean, smart soccer

The Byki Over 40 Team shot up to second place in the Sportszone Over 30 League following their comprehensive 8:6 trouncing of Arsenal last Monday. Over 40 debutante Russ Haynes scored four goals and assisted on two others, while Doug Towsey added a pair of goals. The Byki raced out to a commanding 8:2 lead and then saw Arsenal claw their way back into the game when they took advantage of the Sportszone's juvenile slaughter rules. At 2-0-1 for the season, the squad really came away satisfied with their effort.

Coach Bernhard Kleine was faced with a dilemma when scoring linchpins Dominic Demarets and Bob Marvin were unavailable. Demarets was nursing an injury and was joined by defender Fleet Neighbors, who was suffering with a suspected cracked rib. Kleine called in Haynes and Towsey to fill the void and it was a great example of pushing the right buttons.

The team rebounded from their undisciplined behavior from previous matches. Kleine laid out a firm game plan prior to the match, pointing out his expectations with respect to conduct and behavior, as well as tactical awareness.

Everything fell into place almost perfectly and the Byki victory actually was far more dominant than the 8:6 score indicated.

It took the Byki just five minutes to break out on top. Haynes sliced a very nice diagonal ball in front of the box and Towsey took care of the rest for his first goal of the season.

Haynes did not waste any time to get the score to 2:0 when he stole the ball from a befuddled Arsenal defender. Haynes thrives on these types of opportunities and his shot left the goalie helpless.

Arsenal closed the gap to 2:1 in the 15th minute. Goalkeeper Pete Pruim defused a hard shot by an Arsenal attacker, but the deflection went to an unmarked Arsenal player, who made easy work of the play.

The Byki were aggressive in their marking and hustling the whole time. Their effort paid handsome dividends in the 19th minute. Kleine set up Towsey for his second goal of the contest, giving the Byki a little extra cushion. Now the Byki were on a roll and they upped their advantage to 4:1 just before the break. Haynes made a precision pass to the sprinting Kleine, who sunk the shot without any problem from six yards.

Arsenal were trying hard to make a game of it, but their infrequent attacks were blunted by the defense, with the help of a very sure-handed Pruim.

The second half started where the first half ended. While Arsenal were able to get a quick goal on a shot from distance in the 23rd minute, any hope of getting back into the game were dashed by the rolling Byki express.

The Byki slapped Arsenal with four answered goals in 12 minutes, leaving a lasting impression on their overmatched opponents. Kleine started the scoring binge when he played a long, high ball to Haynes. The striker raced past two defenders and hammered the ball under the crossbar to make it 5:2 in the 26th minute. The opportunistic Haynes made it

6:2 in the 33rd minute when he picked the pocket of an Arsenal defender, leading to a 1 v 1 situation with the goalkeeper. Haynes completed his spree with a third second-half goal in the 35th minute. Brian Cooper made a terrific pass and Haynes buried the chance to put the Byki 7:2 up.

With Arsenal facing a five-goal deficit, Sportszone rules allowed them to add an extra field player. The presence of such a rule may have a place in youth soccer competitions, but adults should have to take their lumps when a mismatch occurs. Are egos really so tender and fragile that players will decompose into weeping little pansies when they're down by five goals?

The Byki were able to ignore the extra man for a short period and increased their margin to 8:2 when Cooper headed the ball near the goal post and Sal Farhan managed a tidy clean-up on the rebound.

Arsenal used the slaughter rule to their advantage were

able to score four goals in the closing minutes (two with the extra player) to make the final tally a respectable 8:6 score.

Kleine was obviously pleased with the new attitude of his team. "There was not a single complaint to the referee, no excessive fouls and only one two-minute penalty for each team," he noted afterwards. "All energy was used to play good soccer, which will help the oldboys to climb in the league standings."

# This week in Byki history



During their 25 years of playing soccer, the Byki have played 1,476 official matches. As the club celebrates its silver anniversary, *Byki Bouncings* will take a walk down memory lane to relive some of the greatest and most entertaining moments in Byki history. *This Week in Byki History* will be a regular feature for all of 2008, as some of the most memorable headlines and stories from *Byki Bouncings* will be reprinted here.

## Treter, Towsey, Chahmirzadi (?) topple West Bosnia

**Matt Treter** scored a pair of goals and **Doug Towsey** had one, as the Byki Over 30 Team beat West Bosnia 5:2 on January 3, 2003. But the most unlikely goalscorer of the night was keeper **Manou Chahmirzadi**. The Bosnians were in the hunt for the NSL playoffs that night and a late Byki surge broke open a 2:2 deadlock, as Doug and Matt scored to put the good guys up 4:2. The Bosnians tried to flood the Byki end of the field with attackers, but the tactic backfired when Manou grabbed a loose ball with 0:20 to go and heaved the ball the length of the field into the empty net on one bounce to seal the deal. Manou became the first Byki goalkeeper to score a goal.

## Hungry Byki eat up Eaton - Sergio goes wild

The Byki clobbered Eaton by a gaudy 12:0 scoreline on January 21, 1988, and striker **Sergio Bertoncello** registered three goals and five assists. It was Bertoncello's third hat trick of the season and the five assists and eight points set the Byki single-game records at the

time. The Byki took third place in the Odeum's D League and Sergio finished that successful season with 12 goals and 11 assists. Those 11 assists broke the existing club record for assists, which Sergio had set two years previously. It remains the fourth-highest assist total for Byki indoor competition.

## Lucky 13 spells Byki win

The Byki Over 40s clobbered the Mavericks in a 13:4 whitewash on January 8, 2007. **Dominic Demarets**, in the middle of mind-boggling scoring run, notched six goals and two assists. The six goals and eight total points were the second-highest marks for one game in the club's history. Dominic went on to shatter the season record for goals and points, with 42 goals and 6 assists.

## Byki put Azteca in their place

The Byki downed Deportivo Azteca 3:1 on January 23, 1998 in the NSL's 1st Division. The victory ignited a six-game winning streak, during which the Byki demonstrated that they were no longer NSL patsies in their second year in the League. Goals by **Ted Snodgrass** and **Carlos Soriano** 1:49 apart put the Byki in control over Azteca and then **Marek Ciszewski's** late goal gave the Byki an unassailable 3:1 lead. The Byki finished that campaign with seven wins in their last nine contests, which erased an ugly start to the season, leading to a final record of 8-1-7.
