Losing streak finally over

The Blue Team used a balanced attack, led by Lazaro Uriza's goal and two assists, to take care of Chicago Celtic 5:2 last Tuesday in the Miro Indoor Soccer League. Six Byki players played a role in the scoring, as the Byki put together their most consistent performance of the season. Their record improves to 2-0-4, as they leapfrogged Celtic in the standings.

The Byki wasted little time putting their stamp on the match, scoring twice in the first five minutes. Kristian Buur looked set to control a ball cleared out to midfield, but Uriza called him off a drilled a long shot into the lower corner. The Celtic keeper never had a chance, rooted to his line the whole time.

Just 1:17 later. Tomek Worek raced towards the goal from the left side and let loose with a big blast that the keeper saved initially. He bungled the rebound, however, and the resourceful Kieron Inalsingh was in the right spot to tap the ball home for a 2:0 lead.

Byki goalie Amit Khankari made a nifty save at the 7:49 mark. The Byki defense partially blocked a kick-in and the deflection sent Khankari the wrong way. He still managed to track the path of the ball to make the grab.

Celtic pulled one back at 15:10 when a kick-in from the right side sailed into the upper corner at the far post.

If that goal renewed Celtic confidence, the Byki did their best to squash that feeling a few minutes later. Uriza controlled the ball at midfield and laid off a square pass to Buur. Recalling the ease with which Uriza had beaten the keeper, Buur showed that he was

not bashful about shooting. The keeper made no attempt on Buur's drive from long range and the Byki were 3:1 up.

With 15:20 left in the game, Worek sprinted down the right side and fired a rocket shot towards the near post. The goalie had that one measured and somehow managed to block it. Moments later, Inalsingh trapped a long clearance out the Byki defensive end and flicked the ball into space for Adam Hodge. The goalkeeper anticipated well and slid in to knock the ball to safety before Hodge could catch up.

As some Byki stewed because they had not expanded the lead, they got a measure of relief with 4:20 to go. Matt Fleming led the charge up the middle after winning the ball from a Celtic player. With defenders backing away, Fleming spotted Sam Onaissi making the run on the right side. The pass was weighted with just enough pace for Onaissi to run onto and the winger made no mistake, crushing the ball past

the hapless keeper.

Celtic tried to make things interesting when a shot eluded the diving Khankari with 3:34 left. But the Byki put a wrap on the victory in the final minute, although they tried hard to botch a two-on-none breakaway. The Byki cleared the ball downfield and caught Celtic with everyone pushed forward, leaving Uriza and Inalsingh to run past the goalkeeper, the very last line of defense for Celtic. The pair got a little too cute and a hustling defender sprinted back to intervene. Just when it looked as though the play was hopelessly bungled, Uriza retrieved the loose ball and dropped a pass back for Worek, who slammed the ball home.

The game ended on an ugly note when a Celtic player slugged Inalsingh in the head. Although there had been hard, physical play from both teams in the match, the referee had done a good job to keep things under control. As Inalsingh allowed the ball to roll over the touch line in the dying seconds, a Celtic player shoved him in the back unnecessarily. As Inalsingh turned to object, the player whacked him in the head, prompting a confrontation before security personnel at The Max escorted the thug out of the building. Before being dumped outside, the Celtic hoodlum tried to justify his actions by claiming that Inalsingh had head-butted him, pointing to his bloodied nose. The referee red-carded the offender and the Byki await to see what sort of punishment the league will hand out to the Celtic player.

The Byki may not have been clicking on all cylinders, but they did enough to thoroughly outplay

an inferior opponent. The improvement in the defense was a welcome relief. It was the first all season that a Byki goalkeeper was not under siege for the entire game. The Byki were in the right spots to block shots and did not mess around in front of their goal.
