Hellenic stomp all over Byki

The Byki dropped their fourth game in a row to start the 2012 season when they endured a 7:0 beatdown from Hellenic United's Blue team last Sunday at College of DuPage. Hellenic were 2:0 up within eight minutes and tacked on three more in the last 20 minutes of the first half. The Byki took some steps towards being competitive after the break, but the hole that they had dug was far too deep.

Team speed was a big difference between the sides. Hellenic consistently got players behind the Byki defense. The home team's ability to make unimpeded runs inside the Byki penalty area led to several ridiculously easy scoring opportunities. Hellenic lead the Major Division's Blue Section with a perfect 12 points from their four matches and it is rather obvious that they have emerged as one of the contenders in the NSL's top flight.

Hellenic needed only six minutes to break into the lead. A winger displayed great hustle to reach a ball near the Byki goal line on the left side. He made a diagonal pass back into the middle, where an unmarked teammate tapped the ball home. Two minutes later, the Byki were embarrassingly asleep on a free kick 30 yards from their goal. Hellenic used a quick restart to send a player in alone behind the defense. His shot from ten yards gave goalkeeper Martin Bertels no chance.

Slack marking in the box led to a three-goal blitz within a span of nine minutes. Simple crosses, simple runs and simple finishes by Hellenic left the Byki staring at a 5:0 deficit at halftime.

The Byki became more efficient with their passing and ball possession in the second half. Did that improvement really made a difference, or did Hellenic merely took their foot off the gas? There's no way to be sure, but the Byki began to penetrate into space in the attacking third of the field.

Declan Geraghty, in his first action for the Byki since returning home from college, sent an incisive through pass for Josh Pirahmadi in the 71st minute. Pirahmadi raced in alone on the Hellenic goalkeeper, who made a bold play to come

off his line and smother the ball.

In the waning moments, Mike Stamatinos intercepted a weak Hellenic goal kick and passed to Marek Ciszewski, who took the ball deep into the right corner. He whipped a cross in for Ammin Mehreioskouei in the middle of the box, who found his opening and fired a shot that the keeper snared.

The Byki are still searching for their first 90-minute effort. They have been chasing the game every week so far and they need to have teams chasing them for a change.

Scrambled Byki all over the place

The Blue Team were on a search for teamwork and cohesion against Gremio FC last Sunday and came up short, as they stumbled their way through a disappointing 6:1 defeat at Argo HS. Gremio consistently put the ball in dangerous positions, testing the Byki defense all day long. They had accumulated a 3:0 lead by the break and then cruised the rest of the way. The Byki fall to 1-0-4 for the season.

Gremio, despite showing a decent level of toughness in 2011, were one of two teams relegated from the 1st Division. They gained a lifeline when the NSL chose to combine the 1st and 2nd Divisions in 2012. Their performance on Sunday clearly demonstrates that they are well equipped to compete at the 1st Division level.

Gremio grabbed the lead after seven minutes. A pass floated in from the right wing found an unmarked striker in the penalty area. With plenty of time to chest the ball down, turn and

shoot, the striker drilled a shot just underneath the crossbar. The scandalous marking by the Byki continued and Gremio doubled their advantage five minutes later. A Gremio ball over the top led to a breakaway, as the Byki defense were slow to react.

The Byki showed signs of life on offense in the 34th minute. Jeremy Slate dribbled the ball to the goal line on the right side and drove a sharp cross to the far post for Jordan Stopka. The midfielder knocked the ball back for Matt LaConte, whose shot from ten yards was blocked by the defense. It was a rare moment of lucid attacking play by the Byki, who spent most of the game holding the ball too much or misfiring on their passes.

Gremio padded the lead three minutes before halftime when a long shot slipped past goalkeeper Amit Khankari's hands to make it 3:0.

Player-coach Kristian Buur had changed the Byki formation to a 3-5-2 in midstream, but the lack of ball possession prevented the wings from fully participating in the attack.

A set piece opportunity in the 53rd minute was inches away from getting the Byki back into the game. Carlos Mendoza sent a corner kick towards the near post, where

LaConte's flick grazed the goalpost.

Two quick scores from Gremio a couple of minutes later put the result beyond any doubt. Both goals were the result of sloppy Byki turnovers in front of their penalty area and Gremio showed the necessary killer instinct to put their chances away.

The Byki got to within 5:1 in the 75th minute. Buur sent a pass to Sam Onaissi, who delivered a superb through pass for Sergii Gonchar. The young striker blazed past the Gremio defensive line and tucked the ball home past the advancing keeper. Gonchar was presented with a similar breakaway situation six minutes later, but the keeper stood his ground and made a tough stop on Gonchar's shot.
