Off-target Over 40s get the win

The Byki finally got on the winning side last Sunday at Oak Brook when they downed St Charles Celtics Green 2:1. The Byki dominated the game up until the final third of the field, where their finishing was atrocious. But they did enough to secure victory and survive a couple of scary moments at the end. Jim Jacobs scored one goal for the Byki and assisted on the other, as the Byki improve to 1-1-4 on the season.

Coach Doug Towsey wanted to see more scoring chances and arranged his lineup accordingly. Late-arriving players, however, scotched those plans and Jacobs, normally a wing player, wound up starting up front. The move was just what the Byki needed, as his energy gave the Celtics back four fits.

That energy translated into an early goal that put the Byki in the driver's seat. Brian Huck led a counterattack along the right wing and slipped the ball to Robert Dec, who took the ball to the goal line. Dec sent a sharp, low cross to the near post, where Jacobs slammed the ball past the Celtics before they knew what had happened.

The Byki were unable to sustain that momentum and the Celtics came back into the game. In the 27th minute, James Vlahakis did well to save a free kick from 25 yards. Three minutes later, the Celtics executed a slick passing combo to get a man open in the box. Vlahakis read the play and blocked the shot.

Two great chances were left on the table by the Byki late in the first half. Dec's cross from the right flank found Mike Cruickshank unmarked in the goal area, but the goalkeeper came up with a miraculous save to deny Cruickshank. Just before the break, the St Charles goalie

coughed up possession just outside the box. Ben Zygmunt carried the ball in and laid off to Huck, who incredibly shot wide.

The Byki brought a greater sense of resolve to start the second half. Two minutes in, Jing Geng placed a cross into the danger zone, where Jacobs headed towards goal. The keeper got a hand to that one, but left the rebound for Huck at close range. The Celtics managed to block the second attempt.

In the 54th minute, Dec swung a booming cross from the right side to Mark Weslar, who found Jacobs in the area. He held the ball just long enough to send a square pass to Huck, who made no mistake, giving the Byki a 2:0 lead. He had a great opportunity to make it 3:0 just three minutes later, but his shot from short range missed the target.

St Charles pulled one back in the 65th minute and the Byki started to wonder whether the missed chances would come back to haunt them. The Celtics created a nervous moment eight minutes from the end when Vlahakis saved an open shot from 15 yards. The Celtics clanged the rebound off of the crossbar. Things got congested in the Byki penalty area as the Celtics pushed more players forward, but the Byki finished the game off to nail down the victory. A Celtics player even tried to push Vlahakis over the goal line after Vlahakis had caught the ball, but that pathetic attempt at gamesmanship failed miserably.

Byki lack magic dust

A late flurry in the first half sent Das Magic into a 3:0 lead over the Blue Team last Sunday and the Byki were never able to recover. Slack marking inside the penalty area was the biggest problem for the Byki, who ended up on the wrong side of a 6:1 final score. The Byki are 0-0-3 for the season.

Although the teams battled on equal terms for control of the midfield in the first half hour, Das Magic maintained the upper hand, thanks to the experience of their squad. Spacing for the Byki and a lack of quick ball movement prevented them from building any attacking momentum. As a result, Das Magic kept up the pressure and the Byki finally cracked.

Das Magic notched two goals within five minutes of one another, following good saves by goalkeeper Aaron Barsotti. On both occasions, the Byki failed to hold their marks and rebound shots turned into easy scores.

Das Magic scored a tremendous goal to go 4:0 up in the 49th minute. A cross came in from the right wing and a striker smashed a mid-air volley across the face of goal, where a teammate headed into the back of the net.

After Das Magic increased their lead to 5:0 in the 61st minute, the Byki kept working and got a small measure of satisfaction when they converted a corner kick into their only tally of the day. Josh Pirahmadi curled the ball into the mixer, where Alan Stevens headed back to Pedro Simas. With an elegant flick over the head of a defender, Simas drilled a shot into the upper corner.

Das Magic weren't finished looking for more goals. They hit the post twice in the late going and executed a counterattack to make it 6:1 in the 85th minute.

Torino trample Over 30s

" Too bad the games aren't played on paper, because the Byki endured one of their worst beatings, a 7:0 shellacking to drop their record to 1-0-4.

Torino executed the simple soccer that the Byki were striving for and they got the results. Torino played the first 26 minutes with only 10 men and were two goals to the good by the time their squad was complete. It was that kind of a day for the Byki and it only got worse as the match wore on.

Jdrzejowski watched the debacle unfold and could only shake his head in frustration. "I don't think the other team had to make one pass that was longer than five yards," he grumbled. "Our team was launching balls all over the place."

Torino added a goal just before the break to take a comfortable 3:0 lead. Things became unglued only three minutes after the halftime interval when Ray Lim was unable to keep up with a Torino striker dribbling in alone on the Byki goal. Keeper Ray Najera came out to challenge, but the striker ran right past him and shot past the prone Robert Dec to make it 4:0.

The Byki really lost their focus in the final 20 minutes. They twice made turnovers in their defensive end and Torino made them pay for those errors. On both occasions, the turnovers left Najera exposed and Torino scored the goals with ridiculous ease.
