90-minute effort fuels Byki win

The Over 40 Team needed nearly four months of the season to finally record their first win of the season and they did it in impressive fashion last Sunday, knocking off Deerfield 3:2 at Oak Brook. The Byki scored twice in the final five minutes to secure the points.

The Byki had earned a forfeit victory over International SC the previous week, following the disbandment of that team. The upper reaches of the Over 40 B Division table remain a long way off for the Byki, but they have played fewer games than the teams in front of them, so there is a very reasonable possibility to see the Byki climb the table.

In order to do that, they will need more performances like this one. Everyone fought to contribute and the players kept pushing the issue for the full 90 minutes. Deerfield eventually ran out of gas and the Byki were ready to grab all three ladder.

After a back-and-forth start to the contest, the Byki broke into the lead on 21 minutes. Sean Marquez dribbled down the left side of the field and was fouled 25 yards from goal. Diego Penafiel lofted a beautiful free kick into the mixer and found Gabriel Rodriguez making the run to the near post for the easy header.

Deerfield struck back in the 27th minute. A midfielder threaded a nice through ball to a winger streaking through the middle of the Byki defense. The Byki were beaten badly and the Deerfield player sent the ball into the back of the net with one touch.

The Byki created two more good opportunities late in the first half. In the 38th minute, Ade Ekundayo came 1 v 1 against the Deerfield keeper but shot directly at him. Five minutes later, Ekundayo crossed to Marquez, whose first-time shot was grabbed by the goalkeeper.

The Byki pressing for a second goal and nearly got one

in the 50th minute. John Park received Penafiel's cross and narrowly missed upper left.

In the 64th minute, Deerfield caught the Byki napping as they set up for a free kick 25 yards from goal. They slipped the ball to an unmarked teammate ten yards out, who slotted into the left side of the net to make it 2:1.

That goal was a wake-up call for the Byki and they turned up the pressure even further. Deerfield eventually ran out of gas and the swarming Byki took full advantage.

BK Park nabbed the equalizer in the 85th minute when he twisted past a defender and sent the ball home into the upper right.

Steven Pedlow scored the clincher two minutes from the end. Penafiel's inch-perfect through pass found Pedlow racing to goal. Pedlow's first tally of the campaign could not have come at a better moment.

Friendly foes split the points

When the Byki hooked up with FC Igloopol in July to enhance weekly training, the decision provided both groups with an opportunity to get game-related action. The teams have been engaging in spirited 90-minute battles every Tuesday, so last Sunday's Over 30 match provided more of the same, except that this time, the score would count. The Byki twice took the lead at Prairie Lakes Park, but Igloopol reeled them back in both times and the sides settled for a 2:2 draw.

The Byki faced a second challenge on Sunday, and it was the abysmal condition of the field. It was barely 60 yards wide and it looked as though the lines had not been painted for a month. The absence of corner flags didn't make it any easier for the linesmen to judge when the ball was in and out.

It took the Byki just nine minutes to grab the lead. Igloopol turned the ball over as they tried to play out of the back. Quavas Kirk pounced and he quickly slid a pass for Carlos Jaramillo, who deftly wrong-footed the keeper to make it 1:0.

Even though the narrow and cramped conditions prevented the Byki from playing their preferred style, they swarmed the middle third of the field. By controlling the tempo in this area, Igloopol were forced to play quite a few long balls, none of which presented any danger.

In the 27th minute, Jaramillo ran free in the Igloopol penalty area. A second goal appeared inevitable, but the keeper blocked his rocket shot.

Five minutes later, Quavas Kirk received a throw-in on the left flank and forcefully cut to the inside. Great reflexes by Igloopol's goalkeeper denied Kirk from close range.

Igloopol found the leveler in the 39th minute. An

Igloopol player won possession in tight quarters deep on the left wing. He sent a cross for the far post, where an unmarked teammate tapped home. It was a frustrating goal to concede, as the Byki had kept Igloopol bottled up for much of the first half.

The Byki came out with energy to start the second half. Just six minutes in, Matt Klosterman carried along the left flank and sent a tantalizing, curling ball into the box for Quavas Kirk. He sped to the byline and laid a diagonal pass back to Klosterman. The midfielder's first-time attempt smacked off of the goalpost.

A few minutes later, the Byki regained the lead, thanks to another collaboration between Kirk and Jaramillo. Kirk crossed the ball into the mixer from the right wing and an Igloopol defender looked to be in position to clear. He inexplicably allowed the ball to bounce and Jaramillo was ready to capitalize. He controlled the ball with chest and calmly slotted home from six yards out.

The lead lasted just four minutes. An Igloopol player launched a long cross from the right corner. The ball sailed over everyone's head and incredibly found side netting at the far post. It was a wonder strike that he would be hard pressed to duplicate.

There were still 29 minutes left for someone to find that clinching goal, but the Byki were the only ones to come close, when Quavas Kirk sent a diving header over the bar in the 76th minute.

The draw puts the Byki level on 19 points with Tricolorii, who have played one fewer match. A pack of four teams are as many as five points behind the Byki and all have played fewer games. The Byki will have to maximize their point total in the four remaining regular-season games in order to maintain their spot in the table.
