Losing streak continues

The Red Team dropped their fifth game in a row last Sunday when Deportivo Colomex won 6:2 in an assertive performance at Oak Brook. Colomex dominated ball possession for most of the first half and were probably unlucky that their lead was not bigger than the 2:1 advantage they held at the break. They fired home three goals in the span of eight minutes midway through the second frame to put away the victory. The Byki still languish in the basement of the Blue Section, with just three points from 11 matches and they trail fifth-place FC Steaua by five points.

Colomex scratched out a 2:0 win over the Byki when the sides met in May. On that day, the Byki failed to convert several excellent scoring chances. In the rematch, Colomex brought a squad fortified by the addition of some strong players and the improvement in quality was evident right from the start.

Colomex pinned the Byki back in their own end for most of the first half. They consistently found gaps in the Byki defense, but were let down by inaccurate shooting. The Byki put up a great defensive fight to try to hold out as long as possible. All of that effort, however, left them bereft of any attacking ideas. The Byki were unable to build a possession game and they constantly gave the ball back to Colomex after having won it.

In the 12th minute, a Colomex cross from the right byline was swatted away by goalie Martin Bertels. A Colomex player running in at the back post for the tap-in flubbed the sitter. Three minutes later, Bertels made a tremendous save on an open shot from close range.

Colomex broke through in the 29th minute when a floated free kick glanced off the crossbar and squeezed in past Bertels. Six minutes later, the score went to 2:0 when an open player in the area found the far post from a tough angle.

The Byki attack sprang to life just before the break when Rissan Sampson pressured a Colomex player in his own end and stole the ball. He fired from 25 yards to score a terrific

goal in his Byki debut.

The game evened out somewhat to start the second half, as the Byki sought opportunities to level the score. Colomex, however, found an extra gear and blitzed the Byki with a three-goal outburst that began in the 67th minute. After Colomex earned a free kick 30 yards from the Byki goal, players from both teams were engaged in a discussion with the referee. Meanwhile, a Colomex player astutely put the ball in play, finding an open man in the box. Bertels had no chance to close him down. The Byki complained that the referee had not given a whistle to restart play. No whistle was required, however, because Colomex never asked for the Byki wall to be moved back.

The stunned Byki never recovered and conceded bad goals in the 73rd and 75th minutes, which gave Colomex a comfortable 5:1 cushion.

The Byki came back in the 77th minute, thanks to a hustle play from striker Ammin Mehreioskouei. The Byki had played the ball deep and a Colomex defender cleared the ball right into Mehreioskouei. Wasting no time, Mehreioskouei took the ball straight to goal and drilled a shot past the keeper.

Byki unable to get in gear

The Blue Team took on 1st Division contenders FC Kosova last Sunday at Oak Brook and were only able to fire blanks, falling 2:0. The defeat drops the Byki to a

disappointing 3-0-8 for the season.

Two decisive goals were all that Kosova needed to claim the three points. The first tally was mired in controversy when the referee whistled for a handball by the Byki in their penalty area in the first half.

The Byki had their best attacking opportunities in the first 20 minutes of the match. The Kosova backline played very conservatively, making sure that nothing got behind them. In the sixth minute, Sam Onaissi and Jordan Stopka played a slick 1-2 on the right side, springing Stopka into shooting position in the box. His shot narrowly missed the near post.

Four minutes later, Luis Ruiz sent a pass from midfield for the sprinting Onaissi. The striker broke in alone on the keeper and ambitiously went for the lob, which went wide of the target.

A really sharp sequence of passes in the 19th minute unhinged the Kosova defense. Stopka combined with Matt Fleming at midfield and Fleming's pass to the right flank opened things up for Onaissi. He sped in alone and fired a hard shot that rattled between the goalie's feet before he final corralled the ball.

The fateful penalty kick came in the 28th minute. The

ball deflected off of Mike Kosinski's arm and the referee immediately pointed to the spot. Kosinski claimed that his arm was next to his body and this was a case of the ball playing the hand. That argument did not fly with the referee and Kosova converted from the spot for a 1:0 lead.

Kosova scored the crucial second goal just five minutes into the second half. They floated a pass into the Byki penalty area. In a moment of confusion, the Byki lost track of their marks, leaving netminder Ray Najera alone to deal with the threat. The Kosova player was right on target to put Kosova 2:0 to the good.

The Byki had no answers the rest of the way. They chased the game for the remaining 40 minutes, but the Kosova defense showed fine discipline and put down the clamps to secure the victory.
